

RESTATED AND AMENDED  
BY-LAWS  
OF THE  
SECTION OF PROBATE, TRUSTS AND ESTATES  
DALLAS BAR ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I

Name and Jurisdiction

Section 1. The name of this Section shall be the Section of Probate, Trusts and Estates.

Section 2. The purpose of this Section shall be to promote the objects of the Dallas Bar Association within the field of probate, trusts and estates, not assigned by the Board of Directors to any other Section or to a Committee.

ARTICLE II

Membership

Section 1. Any member of the Dallas Bar Association, upon request to the Secretary of this Section and upon payment of the dues for the current year, shall be enrolled as a member of this Section. Members so enrolled whose dues are paid shall constitute the membership of this Section.

Section 2. Each member of the Section shall pay annual Section dues. The Council shall set the amount of dues in an amount not to exceed \$50.00 per calendar year. After the initial payment of a member's dues, subsequent dues shall be payable in advance on January 1 of each year. Any member of this Section whose annual dues are not paid by March 1 shall thereupon cease to be a member of this Section but shall be reinstated upon full payment of dues for the year of reinstatement. Section dues for fiscal year ending December 31, 2004 are \$20.00 per member. Dues for members of the Section may be increased or decreased by action of the Council without further approval of the Section or Board of Directors of the Dallas Bar Association if, and only if, such increase or decrease in dues is not by more than \$50.00 per member per year. Any increase or decrease in dues of more than \$50.00 per member per year must be by amendment of these By-Laws.

Section 3. All Judges of Dallas County, Texas, having original probate jurisdiction shall be ex-officio members of this Section, and they shall be exempt from the payment of dues.
